- Create a LastName Photoshop Final Projects folder
 - Picture folders: I need to be able to see the original and edited photos

Final Project (vacation theme)

- Combine at least 4 different pictures for this project (pictures from anywhere)
 - 1 picture must be of you!
- You need to use at least 7 different photo editing or manipulating tools
 - Text tool can be one of your tools!
 - Only count 1 selection tool (Move tool and Zoom tool don't count either)
- Warp Text must be included with a Pattern applied. (i.e. Fish Tales)
- List your 7 Tools & **Additional Criteria** and how they were used/applied

Mainly graded on:

- Appropriate use of tools
- Final appearance--Amount of time and effort—Realistic photo combination

Save As: **Final Project.psd** into your Final Project folder

Additional Criteria—list in word document write-ups

The above projects must contain:

- 2—New Adjustment Layers (Layer Menu or Layer Panel)
- 1—Layer Styles—styles panel (Snow, Rain, Sunset, etc...)
- 2—Filters (any of the filters from the Filter Menu)
- 1—layers with changed blending modes
- 1—Clipping mask—must be logical and fit the image

Extra Credit—list in word document write-ups

- Incorporate Panorama (5pts) (I need to see the original pictures before they were merged into a panoramic shot)
- De-Interlace Video clip (2pts)—should have the video saved in your folder
- Create and use our own Pattern (5pts)—save the pattern to your folder
